The Qur'an is the Muslim holy book and is written in Arabic. Muslims believe that the Qur'an has all the answers to questions about life.


Muslims also believe that human beings were created:


- · to worship God,

- to keep away from the things that God forbids.




Muslims believe that all people are called to

- to remember that they must give an account of their lives on the Day of Judgement.







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
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We pretended we were Muhammad and wrote letters from Mecca about writing the verses of the Qur'an.




We wrote prayers for Muslims all around the world.
