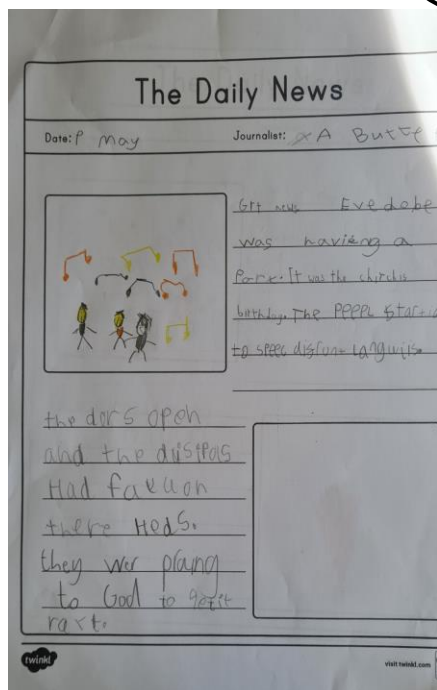


Year 1 - Summer 1: Eloquent & Truthful
